
Lake Billy Chinook - History



AREA GEOLOGY

About 10-12 million years ago, alternating layers of stream sediments, volcanic debris and basalic lava flowed from the Cascade Mountain Range into a huge basin in this area. Named the "Decheurs Formation," these exposed layers of material were capped by lava flows from Cascade volcanos three million years ago. Known as "immoch basalit," the cap is easily seen high atop the stepe differ of the caupons. THE COVE PALISADES

A popular year-round destination for camping and water sports, the park has a history that predates Lake Billy Chinoch. The state leased the first land for a park in the Crooked River Canyon in 1940. The land included a homested anamed the "The Cove" after a popular swimming hole on the Crooked River. The "Pallisades" part of the name refers to the tall column-like formations seen in the basalt timrocks.

The temperature in this Oregon oasis is hot in the summer and mild in the winter. "The Cove" hums with activity on the water: boating, kayaking, fishing, water-skiing and swimming. Park amenities include:

The park's marina concessionaire (The Cove Palisades Resort and Marina) operates a caff and store selling propane, boat full, crecration supplies, ice and faithing licenses and tribal permits. Rentals include houseboats, patio boats, faithing boats, kayaks, ski boats and personal water craft. Visitors also will find a fab cleaning station, boat pump out/dump station, portable toillet dump, pay phone and an ATM.
